- _____ 1 pair of sneakers and/or hiking shoes (comfortable for walking)
- _____ Shoes to get wet-- in the river or in the shower *Suggest no sneakers
- _____ Waterproof poncho
- _____ Coat w/hood
- _____ Laundry bag/garbage bag/or pillowcase for dirty clothes(to separate from clean clothes)
- _____ OPTIONAL: Hat/gloves/scarf

Necessary Equipment

- _____ Leak proof water bottle/Canteen (Very important!)
- _____ Day pack to carry day items (Lightweight DeColores Backpacks would work well)
- _____ Mesh bag to hang dishes to dry
- _____ Sleeping bag
- _____ Pillow (Put in a garbage bag to keep from getting damp)
- _____ 1 Wash cloth and 1 towel (for shower)
- _____ Comb and/or brush
- _____ Soap, shampoo, chap stick, deodorant
- _____ Insect Repellent
- _____ Sunscreen Lotion or spray (It may be combined w/insect repellent)
- _____ Flashlight
- _____ Camera (if you wish) Keep in a sealable bag---it may get wet
