

Grades 3-8 Chess Club



Objectives

- To learn and understand the rules and etiquette of chess playing
- To learn and understand basic chess strategy, openings and tactics
- To learn and understand chess notation
- To learn and become familiar with the literature of chess
- To learn and understand the use of chess clocks
- To field a chess team for state and inter school matches

Requirements

There is no cost to participate in this program, although students should acquire a graph paper notebook and come to the sessions with their own chess pieces and board. It is also highly desirable that the student be prepared to work with a chess program like the Chess Master series readily available for most Personal Computers. Also those wishing to play in the state sanctioned youth tournaments will need to become members of the United States Chess Federation. Students interested in participating on the chess team should also expect to do a little traveling for the tournaments and matches.

The club will take place on Fridays from 2:30-3:30 PM at the DeColores Montessori School. The first session of the program will run from September 18-October 30, 2009. (No Chess Club on Oct. 16).
